## Hells Canyon Mule Days Show Rules:

### Class Schedule:

1. Classes are subject to change without prior notice for poor weather conditions and/or no sign-up's from participants.
2. Classes that are scratched due to poor weather conditions are subject to a full refund of entry fees. A refund request must be in writing.
3. Classes with 4 or more participants qualify for All Around Points and Trophy Awards.
4. Classes with less than 4 participants (except Donkey Classes) qualify for Ribbon Awards for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place, but, will not count toward the All Around or Trophy Awards, in order to assure competitive fairness.
5. Classes with fourteen or fewer competitors are awarded with 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place with judge's discrepancies.
6. Classes with fifteen or more competitors are awarded 1<sup>st</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> place with judge's discrepancies.
7. Pre entry registrations must be POSTMARKED BY AUG. 27, 2007. Send it in by Aug. 27th and save \$\$\$\$\$
8. No participant may compete without having first signed a release form that includes his or her full name and address.
9. Any person 17 years of age or younger may not show or participate without a liable adult or guardian in attendance at the show. Minors must have parent or guardian signature accompany their own on the entry/release form.

### Judging Rules and Regulations:

1. To qualify for judging, exhibitors must appear in the ring appropriately attired and wearing the proper number clearly visible. Numbers can be obtained at the show office.
  - A. Appropriate attire for Western Classes includes long sleeve shirt or blouse, long pants and western hat.
  - B. Appropriate attire for English Classes includes jockey pants, English style riding boots and protective English style head gear.
2. Participants must be ready to enter the arena when called and there will be no refund of entry fees for failure to do so. Gate holds will be allowed for tack and clothes changes and MAY NOT EXCEED FIVE (5) MINUTES.
3. The Judge/Show Committee has the right to excuse any animal/handler from the arena or show, for abuse, un-manageable, profane language or unsportsmanlike conduct.
4. Animals may be shown by different handlers in different classes, but may only be entered ONCE in each class. Each animal will be issued a number which must accompany that animal in each class.
5. Each animal rider combination will have a separate number. Exhibitor must make sure proper number is displayed when participating in the show events.
6. The decision of the Judge is final in all instances.

### Passes:

1. Each participant will be given a \$8.00 HCMD Admission Souvenir Button when they register. Please wear the admission Button so the Event Staff in the spectator area will know you are a participant and won't ask you to pay admission fee.

### Camping:

1. There is no fee for contestants camping in the designated participant area. Sites are dry camping and no advance reservation is needed. (First Come, First Served)
2. There is a \$10.00 a day space fee for non-contestants plus the HCMD Admission Button. Space is limited and reservations are required. Campers can check in at the West gate of the Fairgrounds or at the Show Office after 3:00 pm on Thursday. Please display camping pass in the front window of your vehicle at all times. Up on admission of entry form, exhibitor releases and waives all rights against Hells Canyon Mule Days, Inc., its officers, directors, employees, agents, representatives or volunteers, for personal injury, death, or property damages, and waives the right to litigate or bring action against Hells Canyon Mule Days, Inc. or Wallowa Country Fair Grounds/Board for any loss or damage which is in any way connected with the risks involved in equine activity.

### Entering equidae from outside the State of Oregon:

Basic Oregon State requirements are:

1. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued less than thirty (30) days prior to entry.
2. An Import Permit Number. For permit information call 503-986-4680.
3. A negative test for Equine Infectious Anemia less than six (6) months prior to entry. Test with “pending” results are not acceptable. Oregon will accept either EIA test or AGID test sometimes referred to as a “Coggins test”.

Exceptions: The following are exempt from the EIA test requirement:

- A. Nursing foals under six (6) months of age, traveling with negative tested dam.
- B. All Washington resident horses.

Please Note: The Halter award is a custom designed HCMD halter by Benjamin Gunning of Elgin Boot and Saddles .

Hay will be provided by Hells Canyon Mule Days and located west of the show office. A wheel barrel and sawdust west of the show barn will be available to contestants for stalled animals. Stalls will be provided at a cost of \$8.00 per animal per day. Please request stalls with entry form.

No contestant may advertise an animal for sale unless the animal is consigned to the HCMD Mule/Horse Sale.
