Contestants are advised that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the show officials will disqualify the mule/rider from being judged. Show management reserves the right to remove said mule & rider from show grounds.



## HELLS CANYON MULE DAYS CONTESTANT INFORMATION

**Hay will be provided** at a cost of \$10.00 per bale. Please pay at the show office. Wheel barrels and sawdust will be available west of the show barn for contestants with stalled animals. Tie stalls will be provided at a cost of \$8.00 per animal per day. Please request and pay for the stalls with entry form.

**No contestant may advertise** an animal for sale unless the animal is consigned to the HCMD Mule/Horse Sale. **Entry gate to the arena** – When a contestant is competing in the arena only the next three (3) mules competing will be allowed in this area by the gate. This is to relieve congestion and for safety reasons. Contestant's names will be announced, so please don't be in this area until your name has been announced. Thank you for helping to keep this area free of congestion and safe for contestants.
