HELLS CANYON MULE DAYS CONTESTANT INFORMATION

Helmets will be required in gaming events for any participant under the age of 18 years. Helmets are recommended for 18 years and older contestants participating in gaming events, but not required.

Hay will be provided at a cost of \$10.00 per bale. Please pay at the show office. Wheel barrels and sawdust will be available west of the show barn for contestants with stalled animals. Tie stalls will be provided at a cost of \$8.00 per animal per day. Please request and pay for the stalls with entry form.

No contestant may advertise an animal for sale unless the animal is consigned to the HCMD Mule/Horse Sale. The sale is managed by Intermountain Livestock, Inc. and information and forms are available on the HCMD website www.hellscanyonmuledays.com or contact Annette at IML, 800-824-5298 or 541-963-2158

Entry gate to the arena – When a contestant is competing in the arena only the next three (3) mules competing will be allowed in this area by the gate. This is to relieve congestion and for safety reasons. Contestant's names will be announced, so please don't be in this area until your name has been announced. Thank you for helping to keep this area free of congestion and safe for contestants.

Rules Regarding Jacks – The Wallowa County Fair Board has given a waiver for us to include Jack classes. Please be safe and careful with your jack and for the safety of others and their animals.... We want to continue offering Jack Classes as part of our show each year. Thank you for your help.
